### PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of member of the New York State Assembly for the Thirty-Sixth District in Queens County, caused by the resignation of Zohran K. Mamdani;

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of member of the New York State Senate for the Forty-Seventh District in New York County, caused by the resignation of Brad Hoylman-Sigal;

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of member of the New York State Senate for the Sixty-First District in Erie County, caused by the resignation of Sean M. Ryan;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KATHY HOCHUL, Governor of the State of New York, pursuant to Section 42 of the New York Public Officers Law, do hereby order and proclaim that an election for members of the New York State Assembly and Senate, in the place and for the unexpired terms of Zohran K. Mamdani, Brad Hoylman-Sigal, and Sean M. Ryan are to be held in the said Assembly and Senate districts on the third of February, two thousand twenty-six, and such election is to be conducted in the manner prescribed by law for an election of a member of the New York State Assembly and Senate.
