Secretary Dent called the meeting to order at 11:16 A.M.

Secretary Dent stated that the Board called for an emergency meeting because there is a concern in Bronx County. She explained that the Candidate Records Unit (CRU) staff will report on their materials.

Secretary Dent convened the Hearings relating to consider the candidacy of Eric Stevenson as a Candidate for Delegate to the

Democratic Judicial Convention for the 12<sup>th</sup> Judicial District from the 79<sup>th</sup> Assembly District, Bronx County in the September 15, 2009 Primary Election.

There were no appearances.

Thomas Sattie, Associate Staff Analyst in the Candidate Records Unit, explained the documents to the Commissioners regarding the hearings. After discussion, Secretary Dent inquired if the Board has time to place the candidate back on the ballot by the September 15, 2009 Primary Election. Mr. Sattie reported that he alerted the printing company about this issue and the ballots will be printed in time for the election. The Deputy Executive Director stated that he discussed this matter and a contingency plan for the Bronx Borough Office.

Commissioner Silie stated for the record that all of the relevant parties have been notified of today's hearing and the Board will be true to make sure that the candidate is put back on the ballot.

Commissioner Silie made a motion to put candidate Eric Stevenson back on the ballot for the September 15, 2009 Primary Election.

Commissioner Polanco seconded the motion, which was adopted unanimously.

Commissioner Soumas moved to adjourn the hearings. Commissioner Schacher seconded the motion, which was adopted unanimously.
