2 (The meeting commenced at 1:30 p.m.)

3 MR. STEVEN RICHMAN: Good afternoon,
4 everyone. This is the meeting of the Board of
5 Elections in the City of New York's
6 Commissioners' Cover Sheet and Review Committee
7 Meeting. Pursuant to rule D of the designating
8 petition rules adopted by the Board February
9 2019, specifically Rule D-2, this committee was
10 designated by the full board during its meeting
11 held this past Tuesday. The voting members of
12 today's committee are Commissioner Camilo,
13 Democrat of the Bronx, and Commissioner Shamoun,
14 the Republican of Kings County.

15 I am Steven Richman. I am the general
16 counsel for the Board and I will be calling the
17 calendar and making the recommendations of the
18 staff. A public notice was posted on Tuesday that
19 the meeting will actually begin at 1:30, which
20 means we've got to wait one more minute. And we
21 have received commissioners' notifications via
22 email that several counsels to several candidates
23 will be watching this meeting as well.

24 It should be noted that the

2 commissioners were e-mailed a copy of the staff's
3 petition cover sheet defect list, together with
4 the supporting documentation and we will call and
5 refer them going through. And again, in each of
6 these items, if the commissioners so direct and
7 find that the cover sheet is defective, the
8 appropriate correspondence will go out by United
9 States Postal Service Next Day Delivery, giving
10 the candidate or their designated contact person
11 three business days from today's determination,
12 which would make this midnight next Wednesday to
13 file a purported cure.

14 So, we'll wait another couple of seconds
15 until the clock turns 1:30 and then we'll call
16 the calendar. And commissioners' this is being
17 recorded and being webcast on the Board's website
18 as well with a picture of myself and the screens
19 showing each of you participating as well, and
20 the audio will be recorded in accordance with the
21 governor's executive order to at some point
22 eventually be transcribed.

23 And we are now at 1:30. So,
24 commissioners, the first item we're going to

2 present to you relates to the cover sheet, a
3 Democratic Party cover sheet filed by the
4 candidate with the name of Paperboy Love Prince,
5 a candidate for representative in Congress in the
6 7th Congressional District. The two defects are,
7 and you have the cover sheet attached, is that
8 the candidate failed to list the total number of
9 volumes in the petition. And that's highlighted
10 by the -- what is a red circle on my copy,
11 probably a black circle on yours.

12 And the second one is that the volume ID
13 numbers do not, claimed on the cover sheet do not
14 match to the ones issued by the Board. The Board
15 number this year is the borough, two letter
16 borough code, 2000, followed by a three digit
17 petition number. So it should be -- we only have
18 a five digit number here.

19 So with your approval, commissioners, I
20 will call roll, we will send a notice to the
21 designated contact person, Mr. Goldwater,
22 advising them of those two defects. Commissioner
23 Camilo?

24 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approve.

2 MR. RICHMAN: Commissioner Shamoun?

3 COMMISSIONER SIMON SHAMOUN: Approved.

4 MR. RICHMAN: Thank you. The next
5 defect, commissioners, that was identified by the
6 staff relates to the cover sheet for Christina
7 Nap- N-A-P-L-A-T-A-R-S-K-I, for female member of
8 the Democratic State Committee from the 50th
9 Assembly District in Brooklyn. Commissioners, the
10 defect here was that the rules require that the
11 cover sheet is supposed to match the petition.
12 The petitions include her middle initial of S.
13 All the other information is the same. We're
14 bringing this to your attention to see if you
15 want to force a change. It's only the omission of
16 the middle initial. It's on the petitions, but
17 it's not on the cover sheet.

18 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: What's legal
19 recommending?

20 MR. RICHMAN: Commissioner, this has
21 been the discretionary type of thing, I don't
22 believe it causes any confusion to the objector
23 or anyone else, but again, the guides we have is
24 to report each defect. My recommendation would be

2 not to find it a defect.

3 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: I would follow
4 that recommendation and not find it a defect.

5 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: I agree,
6 especially in these days.

7 MR. RICHMAN: I'm just -- okay, we
8 understand, but I think commissioners again, even
9 with the emergency, we're still going to follow
10 the best of the procedures we can.

11 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Yeah, mm-hmm.

12 MR. RICHMAN: Third item relates to the
13 cover sheet for two candidates for delegate for,
14 to the 1st Judicial District and then from the
15 68th Assembly District, Edward Gibbs and Harry
16 Rodriguez. The petitions addresses are correct.
17 What appears to have happened in preparing the
18 cover sheet, is that on Mr. Rodriguez' address,
19 after his full address is stated, 316 East 117th
20 Street, Apartment 8, New York, NY 10035, the
21 numeral one appears. And on the next line for Mr.
22 Rodriguez, the address is 1809 -- 809 Third
23 Avenue, but on the petitions, it's 1809. So
24 apparently in setting up the cover sheet, the one

2 was not moved down or it had jumped back to the
3 last line. So technically, the addresses on the
4 cover sheet doesn't match the petition. In this
5 case, I would recommend we send a notice to cure,
6 because if somebody relied on the 809 Third
7 Avenue address on the cover sheet, no notice
8 would ever be received.

9 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: I approve.

10 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: I approve.

11 MR. RICHMAN: Commissioner Camilo,
12 Commissioner Shamoun. Thank you, commissioners.
13 And commissioners, you have a copy of the
14 petition pages attached. I forgot to mention that
15 to show the actual addresses. The next potential
16 defects relates to the cover sheet for Daniel
17 Gorman, candidate for New York State, or there's
18 actually two I realize. The New York State
19 Assembly, New York State Assembly -- it was one I
20 should say, in the 75th District. On the cover
21 sheet, he only lists his residence address, which
22 is the only thing that is technically required
23 under the rule. However, the rule also requires
24 it should match the petition. The petition

2 includes his P.O. box because the petition says
3 also include the post office address if not
4 identical. That should have been included on the
5 cover sheet. Again, so if somebody is attempting
6 to serve notice to the individual, and he's going
7 to a mailing address instead, it's not included.
8 My recommendation is we ask him to amend the
9 cover sheet to conform to the petition.

10 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Do we allow
11 service by a P.O. box, to a P.O. box?

12 MR. RICHMAN: Well, the state law, the
13 state format for the, for the address on a
14 petition specifically reads, you have to both
15 list your residence address and your post office
16 address if not identical.

17 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: If not identical.

18 MR. RICHMAN: And in this case, it's
19 not. He has a residence address of 145 East 27th
20 Street and a postal address at P.O. Box 1787,
21 101- at New York, NY 10159.

22 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Okay.

23 MR. RICHMAN: Thank you, Commissioner
24 Shamoun. Commissioner Camilo?

2 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Um, to send
3 notice?

4 MR. RICHMAN: Yes, to correct --

5 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Yes.

6 MR. RICHMAN: -- it conforms. Okay.

7 Commissioners, the next relates to the amended
8 cover sheet filed as of right for candidate
9 Manuel Onativia, for male member of the
10 Democratic State Committee in the 68th Assembly
11 District. Under our -- under your rules adopted
12 under C7, if there are multiple cover sheets or
13 amended cover sheets filed for the candidate, the
14 last one filed shall be controlling. The original
15 one was filed on March 19th, the -- at 5:00 p.m.,
16 the amended was filed on March 20th.

17 The defects for the amended being
18 controlling is one, the name of the party or
19 independent body is omitted from the cover sheet.
20 And two, since it's an amended cover sheet, the
21 required certification or authentication required
22 by C4 is not present. In both cases, those are
23 curable defects at this point, because they were
24 filed as of right. We would ask, recommend that a

2 notice of non-compliance be sent.

3 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approve.

4 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

5 MR. RICHMAN: Commissioners, the next
6 relates to the cover sheet of Jason Haber,
7 candidate for male Assembly District Leader Part
8 B in the 67th Assembly District in New York
9 County. The candidate claims five volumes,
10 including Volume New York 2000279. You have a
11 copy of that complete volume of the candidates.
12 The candidate does not appear on that volume. He
13 appears on the other four, four on his cover
14 sheet. So the volume claimed on the cover sheet,
15 the candidate does not appear on. We would give
16 him notice to correct and we would correct it by
17 removing that volume and submitted the amended
18 cover sheet with the four volumes he appears on.

19 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approve.

20 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

21 MR. RICHMAN: Thank you, commissioners.
22 Okay. Commissioners, the next relates to the
23 Democratic cover sheet filed for Cameron Alex
24 Coffman, C-O-F-F-M-A-N, as a candidate for the

2 New York State Assembly 73rd Assembly District.
3 The cover sheet, as you can see, does not include
4 the petition identification number. He claims one
5 volume, but he doesn't provide the number. I
6 recommend that a notice of noncompliance be
7 issued, directing him to follow an amended cover
8 sheet correctly filled out.

9 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approved.

10 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

11 MR. RICHMAN: Thank you, commissioners.

12 Commissioners, the next item relates to Queens
13 Petition number QN2000565. It's for Candidate
14 Badrun N. Khan for representative in Congress in
15 the 14th CD. Yesterday, John Sphera [phonetic] of
16 my staff, who is a Republican and myself,
17 personally reviewed the volume, and if you see my
18 signatures, found two page number defects.
19 Between sheets numbers 39 and 40, there is a
20 blank sheet, and then in -- there are two, two
21 sheets numbered 201. We would give them -- we
22 recommend that a notice be given directing them
23 to cure it in accordance with our procedure by
24 filing a copy in the exact order and then

2 inscribing therein any corrections to deal with
3 the page numbering defects.

4 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Okay. I was just
5 looking at [unintelligible] [00:12:08] approve.

6 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: I approve.

7 MR. RICHMAN: Alright. Commissioner
8 Shamoun approves, and Commissioner Camilo, was
9 that a yes?

10 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Yes, I approve.

11 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. Thank you. I didn't
12 hear from you. Okay. Next relates to the
13 Democratic Party Bronx County cover sheet for
14 Francisco A. Spies for representative in the
15 Assembly 78th, 78th New York State. We can -- I'm
16 requesting the commissioners, there the total
17 number of volumes in the petition claimed is two
18 but he only lists one ID number. So there's an
19 inconsistency there. So the, as I said, the
20 number of volumes claimed, which is two, does not
21 match the ID numbers state. We'd ask, only for
22 that candidate. The other candidates appearing on
23 this cover sheet, there are no defects.

24 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approved.

2 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

3 MR. RICHMAN: Thank you. Commissioners,
4 the next cover sheet defects relates to the cover
5 sheet filed on behalf of Jose M. Serrano as a
6 candidate for the State Senate from the 29th
7 State Senate District in New York State.

8 Commissioners, there are two defects. One, on the
9 cover sheet, the total number of volumes in the
10 petition is missing. And secondly, in the volume
11 identification numbers claimed, the candidate is
12 claiming Volume two -- Bronx 2000284. That volume
13 has never been filed. So we would identify then
14 both that the total number of volumes in the
15 petition were not there, were not included on the
16 cover sheet and the cover sheets include a volume
17 not filed and give them an opportunity to file a
18 corrected, a cure with an amended cover sheet.

19 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approve.

20 MR. RAPHAEL SAVINO: And I see my
21 handwritten notes there, I couldn't find those,
22 the petitioners.

23 MR. RICHMAN: Oh, okay. Thank you,
24 commissioners. And for the record, that was

2 Deputy General Counsel Raphael Savino by --

3 MR. SAVINO: Oh, sorry.

4 MR. RICHMAN: -- phone. We didn't see
5 you before when we introduced everybody.

6 MR. SAVINO: Yeah, I'm new to this, I'm
7 not sure I did it right, but I just have an R on
8 my screen.

9 MR. RICHMAN: Okay.

10 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: R is for
11 Republican.

12 MR. SAVINO: There you go.

13 MR. RICHMAN: Commissioners, the next
14 cover sheet matter relates to the candidate
15 Emanuel Martinez for male member of the
16 Democratic State Committee from the 78th Assembly
17 District, Bronx County. Commissioners, again, the
18 similar situation, two cover sheets were filed,
19 one on March 19th, one on March 20th. Under rule
20 C7, the latest one filed is controlling. The one
21 filed on March 20th, in front of you, you'll see
22 that the total number of volumes in this petition
23 are omitted and therefore, it is, the cover sheet
24 is defective. We recommend a notice of non-

3 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approve.

4 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approve.

5 MR. RICHMAN: Commissioner Camilo, was
6 that, did you say --

7 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approved, sorry.

8 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. You know, both of
9 you came through I think at the same time. Next
10 relates to the Working Families Party, cover
11 sheet for Karines Reyes, for member of the
12 Assembly from the 87th AD in the Bronx. Two
13 things, commissioners, one the cover sheet was
14 attached to the petition, which violates rule C1,
15 it has to be filed separately. And two, the cover
16 sheet claims volume BX2000591, but as you can see
17 with the attached petition with the signatures
18 for said candidate, the volume actually has a
19 number Bronx 200592. So it's an incorrect -- one
20 is the cover sheet was attached to the petition,
21 and two, it claims a volume for which the
22 candidate, we don't have the candidate actually
23 appears on 592. Recommended notice of
24 noncompliance be issued to correct both defects.

3 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

4 MR. RICHMAN: The next cover sheet
5 defect relates to the Libertarian Party cover
6 sheet submitted for two candidates for the State
7 Committee from the 12th Judicial District,
8 Emanuel H. Torres, and Aaron Ameriel Commey. The
9 cover sheet lists total number of volumes of
10 petition one of one, but the cover sheet fails to
11 include the petition ID number. We recommend a
12 notice of noncompliance be sent allowing them to
13 cure that deficiency.

14 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approved.

15 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

16 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. Commissioners, the
17 next relates to the cover sheet filed on behalf
18 of Shirley K. Sanders as an alternate delegate to
19 the judicial convention from the 82nd District.
20 Commissioners, if you look at the petition page
21 itself, Ms. Sanders is listed as Shirley J.
22 Sanders at the address of 120 Benchley Place on
23 both volumes that were filed for them, 270 and
24 287. However, on the cover sheet, it's listed as

2 Shirley K. Sanders. In this case, since this is
3 not just an omission or different, a completely
4 different one, we would recommend a notice of
5 noncompliance be sent to ask them to correct the
6 cover sheet to match the petitions.

7 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approved.

8 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

9 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. Then the last of
10 these is the, relating to the cover sheet for
11 Candidate James Piro, candidate for member of the
12 Assembly from the 81st District James Hierro
13 [phonetic], candidate for member of the Assembly
14 from the 81st District. The deficiency here is
15 that on the cover -- on the petition filed, his
16 residence address includes his apartment number.
17 And as we've said in the rules while the
18 inclusion of an apartment number is recommended,
19 not optional, we do require that the information
20 contained on the cover sheet, under Rule C2i must
21 be identical to the information printed on the
22 petition. In this case again, if someone only
23 looked at the cover sheet, they may not be able
24 to get the mailing out. We recommend that the

2 cover sheet should conform to the petition since
3 he included it on the petition.

4 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approved.

5 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

6 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. Okay, commissioners,
7 those are the cover sheet defects, the initials.
8 Give me a second and we will move now to the page
9 numbering defect cures that were filed in
10 response to the action of the Commissioners Cover
11 Sheet Review Committee on Tuesday.

12 The first is the amended pagination for
13 Kings County Volume KG200257. There were two
14 defects, two pages numbered 101 and four pages
15 numbered 136. On 3/26, commissioners, if you can
16 see, we compared with the original petition. We
17 recommended it's a valid cure, and just to show
18 you, commissioners, the change. It was done very
19 well this way. It really made it easier. Once
20 they had the two number page 101s, they crossed
21 it out in red and wrote the new page numbers all
22 the way through in red, clearly identifying it.
23 We recommend that the commissioners deem this to
24 be a valid cure.

3 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

4 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. Commissioners, I'm
5 just going to print your names. Okay. Very good.

6 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Are these also in
7 the same .PDF?

8 MR. RICHMAN: No. We didn't send those,
9 because commissioner, if you look at the size of
10 the correction.

11 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Okay, yeah, yeah.

12 MR. RICHMAN: If I modify them.

13 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Alright. I
14 understand, thank you.

15 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. You have to zoom in
16 on me. That's number one. The second one, cover
17 sheet, I should say page numbering defect for
18 volume New York 2000275 for Candidate Lindsay
19 Boylan for member representative in Congress from
20 the 10th Congressional District. Commissioners,
21 again, in this case, page 80 was followed by a
22 blank page and then page 81, we have reviewed
23 that submission, we compared with the original,
24 the valid cure is done, and the cure now show

2 page 80, the blank page is numbered 81, the page
3 that was numbered 81 became 82 and successfully
4 and correctly numbered in the same order as the
5 exact petition to page 225. So we recommend that
6 this is a valid cure in compliance with the
7 Board's directive on how to cure.

8 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approved.

9 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

10 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. Okay. Commissioners,
11 the next defects, cover sheet defect, related to
12 Bronx Volume 2000324 for a series of candidates
13 for the Republican Party as member of the
14 Assembly delegates, alternate delegates in the
15 80th Assembly District, along with the candidates
16 for district -- that's it, in three, for this
17 one, in 324, those are the candidates. The
18 petition was submitted not being numbered at all.
19 A copy was filed. Mr. Sphera and I personally
20 compared with the original. It remains in the
21 exact order, and now each and every page in said
22 volume is sequentially numbered, so we recommend
23 that it's a valid cure.

24 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approve.

2 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

3 MR. RICHMAN: Commissioners, similarly
4 for Volume BX2000323, this was Bronx Republican
5 petitions for the member of the State Senate in
6 the 33rd Senate District, member of the Assembly,
7 delegates and alternates in the 86th AD. Again,
8 the entire volume was submitted without page
9 numbers. Mr. Sphera and I compared the original
10 with the purported cure. The pages are in the
11 exact same order. They are now sequentially
12 number from pages 129. We recommend that this be
13 deemed a valid cure.

14 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approve.

15 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

16 MR. RICHMAN: Thank you, commissioners.
17 Okay. The next relates to the cure for Queens
18 volume 2000974 for Alka Mansukhani, candidate for
19 member of the Democratic County Committee, 75th
20 ED, 37th AD, commissioners this was a four, a
21 three page petition, but it was assembled -- a
22 four page petition but it was incorrectly
23 numbered, it ran one, two, four, three. They
24 ordered a copy and it's now correctly numbered in

2 the exact order we reviewed it. Now, it's one,
3 two, three, four. We recommend this to be a valid
4 cure.

5 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approve.

6 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

7 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. The next relates to
8 Queens Volume 2000411, which con- which is an
9 omnibus petition for a large number of candidates
10 including in the Democratic Party, for borough
11 president, judges of civil court, State Senate
12 and the 13th Assembly District, and party
13 positions and members of the Assembly for the
14 34th Assembly District. Again, commissioners, in
15 this case, the entire volume was submitted
16 without page numbers. Mr. Sphera and I compared
17 with the original yesterday. It is in the exact
18 ordered filed, and now it is sequentially
19 numbered on each page beginning with one through
20 page 79. We recommend that you deem this to be a
21 valid cure for Volume 411.

22 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approved.

23 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

24 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. We'll move now to

1 March 27, 2020

2 Queens Volume 2000410. Again, for Democratic
3 Party, candidates for judge, civil court judge,
4 borough presidents, State Senator from the 13th
5 and again, candidates for Assembly and Party
6 positions in the 34th Assembly District. Same
7 issue, the entire petition was filed, a volume
8 was filed without pages being sequentially
9 numbered. Mr. Sphera and I yesterday compared
10 with the original, found it to be in the exact
11 same order, and now sequentially numbered from
12 pages one through 60. We recommend this to be a
13 valid cure.

14 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

15 MR. RICHMAN: Commissioner Camilo, we
16 didn't hear. Was that a yes?

17 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approve, yes.

18 MR. RICHMAN: Okay. And now to Queens
19 Volume QN2000408, again, Democratic Party
20 candidates for borough president, judge, member
21 of the Assembly and party positions in the 33rd
22 Assembly District. Again, the entire volume was
23 filed without page numbers. Mr. Sphera and I
24 yesterday compared the original with the

2 purported cure. It is in the exact same order and
3 the pages are now sequentially numbered from one
4 through 42. We recommend this be deemed also a
5 valid cure of the page numbering defect.

6 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Approved.

7 MR. RICHMAN: Commissioner Camilo?

8 COMMISSIONER CAMILO: Approved, sorry.

9 MR. RICHMAN: I'll make sure we hear it.

10 And commissioners, that concludes the cover sheet
11 review for today.

12 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: That's it?

13 MR. RICHMAN: That's what we got so far.

14 Yes. The team, right now, it's only one team
15 that's continuing the cover sheet review. We have
16 parts, a whole borough of Queens to get through
17 and still significant parts of Brooklyn and
18 Manhattan.

19 COMMISSIONER SHAMOUN: Okay. Well, be
20 safe and thank you for all your help and all your
21 hard work.

22 MR. RICHMAN: Thank you, commissioners.

23 And Commissioner Marmorato, hopefully, it's a
24 little educational and in the future, in person,

MR. RICHMAN: Commissioner Camilo, I would recommend you make a motion to adjourn.

COMMISSIONER CAMILO: I move to adjourn the committee.
