2 (The meeting commenced.)

3 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE: Good morning,
4 today is Friday, November 20, 2020. And here at
5 the Board of Elections in the City of New York,
6 we will be conducting the random draw for the
7 audit of the central ballot scanners for the
8 general election on November 3, 2020. We will
9 conduct the drawing for the election districts
10 for the borough of Richmond County in the City of
11 New York. We will start with opening the file
12 containing the EDs for Richmond County and
13 obtaining a random sequence from random draw dot
14 org.

15 To generate each sequence, we will enter
16 the given number of EDs into the corresponding
17 random.org field and running the random sequence.
18 We will then copy and paste a generated sequence
19 into the corresponding column of the ED
20 spreadsheet, then sort the data in said column
21 accordingly. Both spreadsheets and the random.org
22 generated sequence will be saved separately.
23 We'll now begin.

24 UNIDENTIFIED MALE: Okay. So, we have

2 for Richmond County, 327 EDs so we are going to
3 enter that sequence value. And our random
4 sequence is generated. So I am going to save
5 that. Okay. Okay, now I'm going to grab the
6 sequence, actually starting at the bottom is
7 easier. And we'll paste it into our Excel
8 spreadsheet. Did I get the right column? I don't
9 think I -- no, I did not get the right column.
10 Okay. Alright. Paste it. I just need to make that
11 font a little bigger. There we go. Okay. So, we
12 have our sequence and we're just going to flip it
13 so that we randomize our EDADs corresponding.

14 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE: Matt, Matt?

15 UNIDENTIFIED MALE: Yeah, now where is
16 that?

17 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE: You have to select
18 the EDs.

19 UNIDENTIFIED MALE: Right. Well,
20 actually it can, it can be done this way too. Let
21 me just open this up for a second. There it is.
22 And there we go. So now we flipped the
23 randomization into the EDs and then we have our
24 top ten EDs randomized, and there they are. And


now we're just going to save our document. And
